Hope you all are doing well.

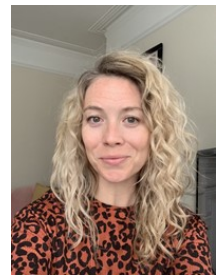
As part of introducing new members of staff, this week we are going to introduce Miss Warde and Miss James. Please read below their statements:

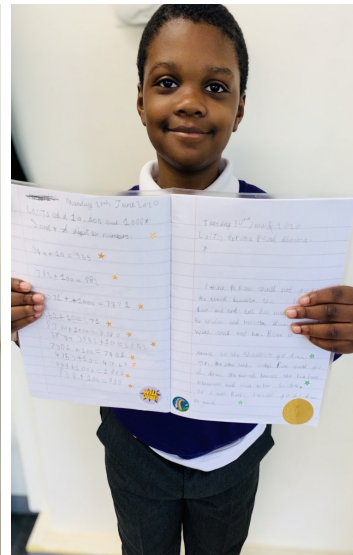
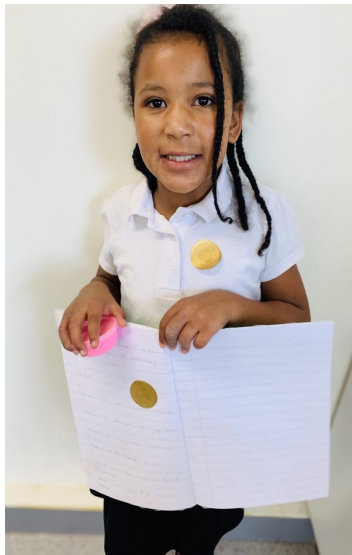
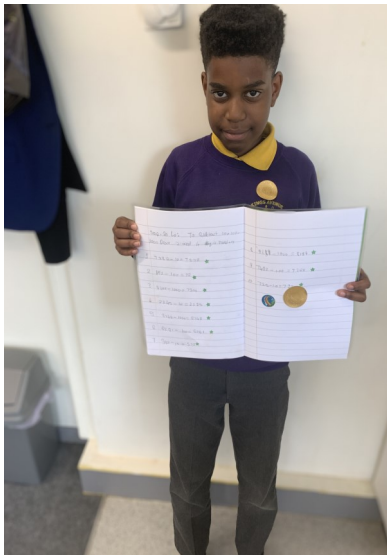
## Wellbeing Activity: Smells!

Ask your parent / carer's permission hold a blindfolded smell session of some lovely things in your home.

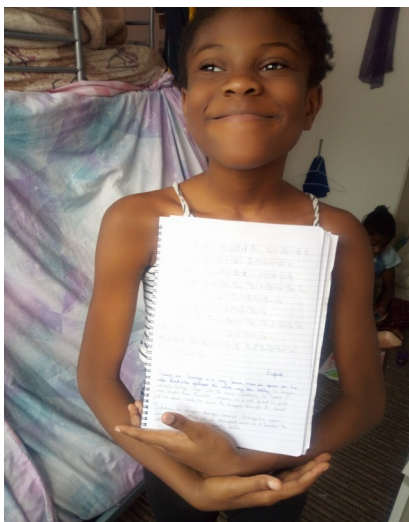
