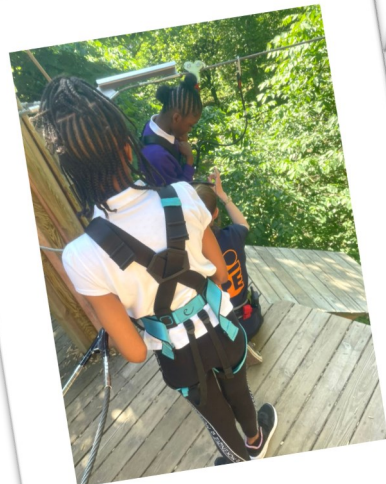
Superhero Sculptures
