# All newspaper reports need the 5 w's

- All newspaper reports need the 5 w's so that the reader can get a good idea about what is happening in the report.

# Who?

Tells the reader who the person or people that the news report is about.

E.g a girl called Katie

# What?

Refers to the situation or problem that the piece of news resolves around.

E.g A fire!

# Where?

Where did the event take place? Which town, city, village? Description is great here too!

E.G In the countryside, in a shop

# When?

- Tells the reader the time the events happened, the year, the date and if possible the exact time!
- E.g At two o'clock on Thursday

# Why?

This is probably the most important W! Make sure you explain in lots of detail here.

E.G Because the robber wanted money or it was an accident.
