All newspaper reports need the 5 w's

 All newspaper reports need the 5 w's so that the reader can get a good idea about what is happening in the report.

Who?

Tells the reader who the person or people that the news report is about.

E.g a girl called Katie

What?

Refers to the situation or problem that the piece of news resolves around.

E.g A fire!

Where?

Where did the event take place? Which town, city, village? Description is great here too!

E.G In the countryside, in a shop

When?

• Tells the reader the time the events happened, the year, the date and if possible the exact time!

• E.g At two o'clock on Thursday

Why?

This is probably the most important W! Make sure you explain in lots of detail here.

E.G Because the robber wanted money or it was an accident.
