# What is an adjective?

- An adjective is a word that describes a noun e.g the HUGE cat.
- A noun is a thing, person, or place e.g Bob, New York, chair.

Noun	Adjective
large	dog

### **Expanded Noun Phrases**

An expanded noun phrase is a phrase made up of **a noun** and **at least one adjective**.

If you list more than one adjective to describe the noun, you should add a **comma** to separate them.

# lots of yummy, cold ice cream

#### Determiner

Used to introduce a noun to specify which one or how many; a/an, the, three, most.

#### Adjective

A word that describes a noun; monstrous, vivid, delightful, familiar.

#### Noun

A person, object or animal; garage, Henry, leopard, sofa.

# Why do we need to use expanded noun phrases?

■ It is important to use these in writing so that it is more exciting!

In diaries it is especially important so that the reader can visualise what is being described in their heads.
